Digitalization offers tremendous opportunities and potential for future applications across various areas while simultaneously presenting demanding technological and regulatory challenges.

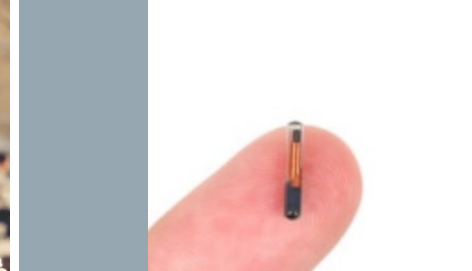
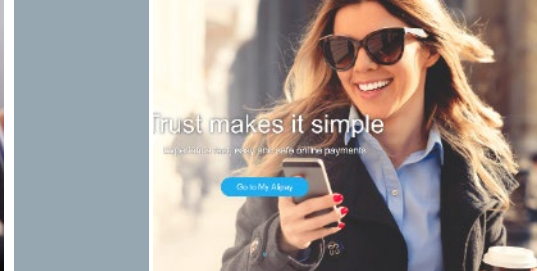

However, its vision has since evolved to next generation secure access based on UWB in phones.

The upcoming usage scenarios for our power grid will bring a tremendous amount of new requirements and challenges to keep the power network stable and reliable. ICT and industrial smart grid components are the enabler for the necessary underlying functionalities. This presentation will identify and motivate realistic use cases in this environment and introduce smart technical solutions to address these challenges.

Digitalisation will change the way we use the modes of transportation on offer. Access to public transport can be made even easier across all segments of customers. Automatic ticketing solutions, such as post pricing after a trip, are expected to be a central enabling issue. Smartphone-based applications are already available in Switzerland for automatically capturing a trip and for calculating the appropriate price of the ticket. The Project "Vertriebslandschaft 2020" aims to coordinate these Apps and to develop a standard for integrating them.
